On the steam trial of this vessel it was found that the water gauge of the boiler was not in proper working condition. As the vessel was leaving for Cardiff, the Surveyors there were instructed to attend to the matter and to report when the water gauge was put right. No report has yet been received from them.

It is submitted that in view of the vessel apparently being now detained solely on account of the certificate being withheld, and that the next Classing Committee will not meet until Tuesday next, the vessel might be now classed subject to the <sup>water</sup> gauge being found to be in good order, the certificates being forwarded to the Surveyors who should retain them until a satisfactory Report has been received from the Cardiff Surveyors regarding the water gauge.
