The difficulty which has arisen in this matter of short weight I account for by the studs being rather lighter (these same studs used to be constantly used for the purpose) the strength of the chain or the quality is not affected in the least by the studs being a little lighter.

If you will gauge the chains you will find that the iron is of correct size required.

I shall be much obliged to have this matter cleared up - & I am sure that it will not occur again.
