In reply to your letter of the 8th inst., respecting the cables supplied by your firm to the Campbelltown Shipbuilding Company, Campbelltown for their No. 35 s.s., if the test certificates of these chains are now in your possession will you please send them here for reference in dealing with the case.

With reference to the remarks contained in your letter, as to weights of cables being based on Table 22 for May 29. 1890, I see the Rules then required a weight of ^{ant. grs. lbs.} 274 " 1.0, and as the cables in question are ^{ant. grs. lbs.} 269 " 3.19, will you kindly explain the difference, as the case will require

to be submitted for the further consideration of the Committee.
