Sir,

I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Owners of the steamer "NEPTUNE" ex "JAMES WATT", No.26 in the Supplement, in which it is stated that the vessel is now at Rouen loading for Algiers from which port she will proceed in ballast to Bilbao. On her arrival at your port about the third week, in March she will be submitted to the completion of the Special Survey No.3.

This survey has been held in part at Port Glasgow by the examination of the ~~hull~~ in dry dock, Engine & Boiler Space, the side bunkers below the close ceiling and the pumps and sluice valves. A leaky rivet in the outside platine has been temporarily repaired by a nut and screw bolt, which it proposed to renew with a rivet when the vessel is next placed in dry dock.

I have to add that the vessel has been fitted with New Boilers and the complete survey of the Boilers and Machinery has been held.

I have therefore to request that on the vessel's arrival you will give the case the necessary attention.
