Portion of Survey held, &c.

The S.S. No. 3 became due 2, 93, and the year of grace expired in February, 1894.

In August last the vessel being then laid up, the former Owners furnished a guarantee that the S.S. No. 3 would be completed before the vessel again proceeded to sea, and intending purchasers and similarly interested parties informed that this was a condition upon which the vessel retained her class in the Register Book.

The S.S. No. 3 was part held at Greenock, per Greenock report No. 11189, when the Owners stated they wished to send the vessel for one or two voyages, after which she will go to Bilbao for the completion of the S.S. No. 3.

On the 8th. instant, the Committee decided that in view of the fact that the survey in question was so long overdue, the Owners should be informed that in order to entitle this vessel to retain her class in the Register Book, the whole of the survey should be completed without further delay, and they were requested to make arrangements accordingly.

The Owners now state that the vessel is at Rouen loading for Algiers, from which port she will proceed in ballast to Bilbao, arriving there about the third week in March, when the S.S. No. 3 will be completed without fail.

It is submitted the Owners proposal merits the favourable consideration of the Committee. The Bilbao Surveyor should be advised of the case, and requested to give it the necessary attention in due course.
