It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the Surveyor should be requested to state if all the reverse frames extend to the spar deck in way of bridge house, and also if the weight of the cast steel heads of the anchors as given on the report, include the weight of the pins, as the weights given are lighter than those allowed by the Rules. If the weights given include the weight of the pins, he should be requested to state why he accepted these anchors, ^{as} when they do not comply with the Rule
