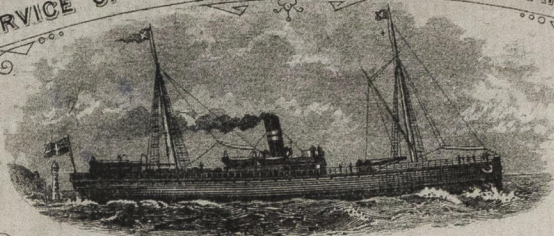

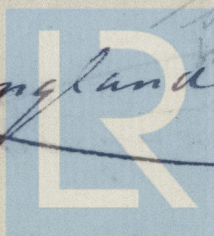
S. S. "Princess Louise".
