Gentlemen,

I duly received Mr. Tierney's letter of the 5th instant, respecting the alterations proposed to be made to the T.S.S. "ANGLIA" by the Grangemouth & Greenock Dockyard Co., and with regard thereto I have to request that you will obtain from the Builders a plan showing clearly the alterations it is proposed to effect to this vessel, and in particular showing the outline of the web frame which, it is stated, is to be cut, and what compensation is proposed for cutting this web frame.

The two plans handed in at this Office by the Builders' representative, Mr. Millar, Junr., are enclosed herewith together with the first entry report of the vessel and the approved sketches of midship section and profile and the plan recently approved of the structural alterations which is now proposed to be again modified.

I may add that the remainder of the approved plans appear to be in the Greenock Office.
