With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Steamer "COUSINS ARBIB", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had under their consideration a letter received from this Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, from which it appears that an examination has been made of the vessel's Boilers with a view to ascertaining their present condition. It is understood, however, that it is your intention to offer the vessel for sale.

In these circumstances, and in view of the 2nd Special Survey No.3 having become due in February 1908, and of the vessel being laid up at this time, the Committee are agreeable to the Survey in question being postponed for the present in the event of it not being convenient to you to complete the same at an early date on the following conditions, namely;— that the Survey and repairs be carried out before the end of next month, when the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Survey will expire, and that you undertake to have this done if the vessel remain your property, and should she be offered for sale, to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain.
