With further reference to the case of the Steamer
"Cousins Arabis" I beg to inform you that I have seen Mr. Tideman
to day.

The vessel is practically sold to a Belgian firm but it has not yet
been finally settled whether sellers or purchasers shall pay for
the survey.

Hull, machinery and boilers are now being opened out, and
a rough outline of the necessary repairs has been given to Owners.
Details can not yet be given as the various parts are not yet
properly ~~repairs~~ prepared for survey.

It is however almost a certainty that the survey will be comple-
ted this time.

Mr. Tideman authorised me to write to you in reply to the secreta-
ry's letter of the 22nd addressed to him, that the 2nd special survey No 3
will be completed before the end of next month or that the class will be
abandoned, and that this will be communicated to intending
purchasers.
