

Hamburg the 18<sup>th</sup> March 1874

Sir

I have to acknowledge the receipt  
of your letter of the 14<sup>th</sup> Instant the contents  
of which I took due notice of and reply re-  
spectfully to the same, that in the case of the  
"Maria Charlotta" the principal motive  
which lead me to recommend for this vessel  
the class A in Red, was the great strength  
of the construction of this ship's the still good  
condition of the material and timbers in  
general, with the only exception of those  
stated in my report as being defective,  
what I thought to be unimportant, especially  
as I found the outside planking and the fast-  
ening of the riegel in a very excellent state.

I was under the impression that the  
state of the said riegel was sufficient to justify  
the recommendation for the said character and  
have not been any way influenced in my  
duty by the owners or any body else.
