The scantlings of this vessel are not in accordance
with the Rules, ^{for the 100A class} and the 95A class was assigned her by
the Committee.

The Owner, Mr. A. S. Bordes, demurs at the
vessel not receiving the 100A class, but, it is submitted
that the deficiencies ^{from the Rules} mentioned in the Secretary's letter
of the 8th Inst. are not considered to be compensated
for by the foundation plates & the 'tween deck stringer,
and the vessel does not appear to merit the 100A class
