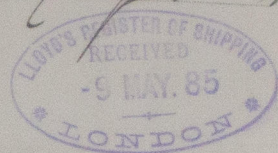

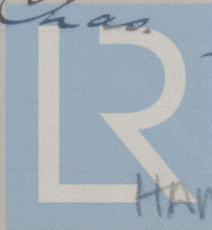
In reply
