Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of to-day regarding the case of the S.S. "STOCKHOLM", which being decoded reads as follows:-

"Stockholm under survey of Society's Surveyors Gothenburg
 "Owners request to be informed what is required to be
 "supplied to complete equipment to entitle the vessel to
 "figure 1 (for equipment) cable reply matter very urgent."

In reply thereto I am directed to state that nothing is known in this Office as to what may be required to complete the equipment, and it is thought that your enquiry should be addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Gothenburg, where the vessel is under Survey. They have already been advised as to the chain cable required for the vessel.

I have therefore wired you to-day as follows, namely:-


STOCKHOLM
