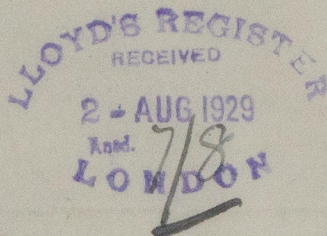

Referring to my letter of yesterday's date regarding the equipment of the steamer "SOLGLIMT", I think it well to add that Dr. Smith, the Owners' representative, strongly objects of having the length of the chain cables increased to <sup>7 really</sup> 345 fathoms as the rule length for the equipment number n<sup>o</sup> is only 330 fathoms.

Dr. Smith fails to see that the increasing of the length of the cable in any way compensates for the smaller diameter of the same.
