

Steamer "SOLGLINT".

This vessel is being converted into a whaling factory at Gothenburg.

A plan showing the hatchway in the weather deck to the whale deck space and to the tween decks aft submitted, in duplicate, by the Gothenburg Surveyors.

To suit the working of these ships it is necessary that these hatchways should be flush.

It is submitted that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended on the plan and to the satisfaction of the Surveyors the same will merit approval.

The Surveyors must satisfy themselves with regard to the method of securing these flush covers in place and for making the same weather tight.

With reference to the drainage of B deck it is observed that it is proposed to fit overboard scuppers with stern valves, instead of scuppers led to the bilges. The Surveyors should be requested to forward a plan showing the number and disposition of the proposed scuppers and the method of control.
