Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that we have forwarded you for consideration, under separate cover, 2 plans, in duplicate, of hatches in A:deck in the steamer "SOIGLINT".

It will be noted that the hatches on this deck are all flush as this is necessary for the working of the ship. The hatches on B:deck have coamings 815 mm. in height, and that deck will be drained by means of scuppers fitted with storm valves led overboard.

Two plans of hatches approved in this office are enclosed for reference, which please return after noting.
