Dear Sirs,

With reference to previous correspondence respecting the conversion of the s.s. "SOLGLIMT" for the carriage of whale oil in bulk, I have to inform you that Mr. Christensen has called at this Office and stated that Mr. Arnesen, of his firm, had requested him to take up with this Office the questions of the fitting of brackets connecting the side stringers to the transverse bulkheads in the tanks, and of the equipment.

I shall therefore be glad if you will forward to this Office a sketch shewing the Builders' proposals for efficiently connecting the side stringers to the bulkheads. In this connection I may add that it is understood Mr. Arnesen considers that brackets need not be fitted.

I shall also be glad if you will state the equipment number, and the present position regarding the equipment of the vessel.

In the circumstances I have wired you today as per copy of translation enclosed.
