Dear Sirs,


I duly received your letter of the 9th instant respecting the S.S. "SOLGLINT", and note that the Owners desire to utilise the semi-circular trough which is fitted in the ship's side as an additional whale oil tank, and that the top of the trough will be made oiltight by portable webs and plate covers; the outer end of the trough will be closed by the portable door, and the inner end by a portable bulkhead.

With regard thereto I am directed to state that no exception will be taken to the proposals, provided the means adopted for closing this additional oil tank be made oiltight to your satisfaction.

One copy of the plan forwarded by you is returned herewith, and the duplicate is being retained.

At the same time I have to state that the arrangements as shown on the sketch of middle line 'tween deck bulkhead between frames 126 and 148 will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.
