In reply to your telegram of the 19th I wired as follows
"Zamir Stepanovitch freeboard is correctly marked - Verification posted 24 ult. -

I cannot understand how the latter can have gone astray, as the examination was ^{made} immediately on the arrival of the vessel at this Port, and the "Verification Form" duly forwarded.

I found the marks as mentioned in your letter of the 6th ult. to be all much too high, and accordingly had the old marks painted out and fresh lines cut and painted, in my presence - I herewith forward a copy of the "Verification Form" posted on the 24th November last.
