

**ZANNI STEFANOVICH** (s). — *Sebastopol*, Jan. 4, 11 49 a.m.—Telegram received from Constantinople states:—Zanni Stefanovich No. 92, which sailed on Dec. 28 from Sebastopol, has not arrived, and anxiety is felt for her safety. Weather unusually bad.

**ZANNI STEFANOVICH** (s).—*London*, Jan. 5.—The following telegram has been received to-day, dated Pera, Jan. 4:—Zanni Stefanovich (s) left Sebastopol Dec. 28; up to present no news.

**ZANNI STEFANOVICH** (s).—*Sebastopol*, Jan. 7, 5 29 p.m.—Stefanovich (? Zanni Stefanovich) had not arrived Constantinople yesterday, and anxiety is felt for her safety.

**ZANNI STEFANOVICH** (s).—*London*, Jan. 8.—The following telegram has been received to-day from the owners, dated Pera, Jan. 6:—Up to now no news Zanni (Zanni Stefanovich.)

**ZANNI STEFANOVICH** (s).—*London*, Jan. 11.—Zanni Stefanovich (s), from Sebastopol for Marseilles:—The owner in London of the above steamer received a telegram from Constantinople, dated yesterday, stating that there was no news of her. A letter dated Constantinople, 3rd inst., stated that the steamer left Sebastopol with a cargo of grain on the 28th ultimo, bound for Marseilles to discharge. The weather in the Black Sea for some days after the steamer's departure was very bad. A number of steamers that left Sebastopol after the Zanni Stefanovich had arrived.

**ZANNI STEFANOVICH** (s).—*London*, Jan. 11.—To the inquiry whether steamer Zanni Stefanovich, from Sebastopol for Marseilles, has arrived at Constantinople, Lloyd's Agent telegraphs under date Jan. 11, 4 10 p.m., as follows:—"Zanni Stefanovich not heard of. Agents here have given her up for lost."—[See issue of yesterday.]
