Sir,

In reply to your letter of yesterday regarding my first entry report on the S.O. "Birdswald" I would respectfully state that the fair plate to hold brand trigger should have been  $\frac{10}{20}$  on the Report this having been increased beyond the  $\frac{8}{20}$  approved by the Committee. The awning deck Sheerstrake is similar to what was fitted in the "Herald" & "Easing". West Hartlepool Reports Nos. 8754 & 8761, these four <sup>Sir</sup> Reports Nos. 189, 190, 191 & 195 were all fitted this way owing to the quarter deck being 5 ft. in height. On the vessels now building Nos. 192, 193 & 194 the quarter deck has been reduced in depth & the awning deck Sheerstrake increased to 36" in breadth as required.
