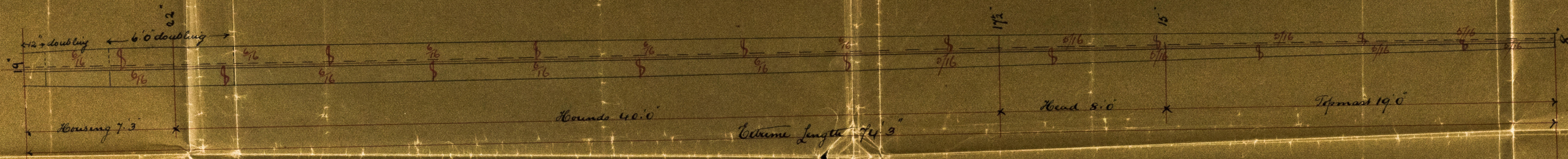

31 Feb 1860 Sank to Putney.

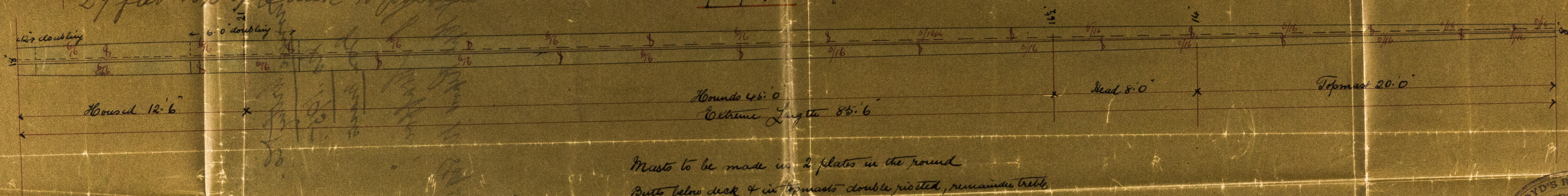
FOREMAST.
