Sir,

With reference to my First Entry Report on
the S.S. "Manningtry" (Furness withy No. 204)
forwarded to day, it will be seen from Copy of my
letter to Builders attached to Report, that, notwithstanding
repeated applications to them to fit the face angle to after
hold stringer in the short spaces where omitted, as shown
on plan of hold stringer forwarded you with my letter of
9th inst., and retained in London, the vessel has now been
sent to the Tyne to load, without this having been done.

It has been pointed out to the Builders that
it now remains with the Committee to determine what
action, if any, they will take with regard to the class of
the vessel, seeing that their requirements have not
been entirely complied with.
