In sending your letter to Messrs. Menzies & asking them to state what they propose to do in the matter.

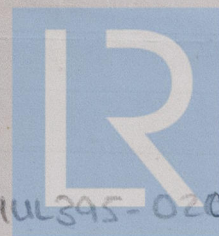
As Mr. Menzies will be coming to Cardiff I presume the engineer surveyor here will inspect, when details are completed as per your letter.
