

Iron Screw Steamer "Bassano", 1822 tons,
No 124 in the Register Book, built at Middlesbrough, in
1842 & classed 90A1.

This vessel is now undergoing Special
Survey^{No 3} at Hull, and the Owners request that, as all the
ceiling in holds, was renewed ~~when~~ under Special Survey No 2
in 1849, if the timber boards, equal to 3 strakes on each side,
be now removed, and the frames, cement &c, found in good
condition, the further removal of the ceiling may be
dispensed with.

It is submitted that as the full requirements
of S.S. No 3, as regards removal of ceiling in the holds
was complied with, provided the remaining requirements be
now carried out, Special Survey No 1 be fully complied with
in other respects, the vessel will be eligible ^{to retain her present class &} to be marked
in the Register Book
