Dear Sir,

With reference to your letters of the 29th July and 2nd ultimo respecting the classification with this Society of your Company's vessels, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under consideration the cases of the Steamers "LINCOLN", "LUTTEWORTH" and "WARRINGTON".

It appears from a communication which has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull that owing to the fact that these vessels have already undergone the annual Board of Trade survey, you are desirous of postponing the surveys now due under the Rules of this Society until they are submitted for the Board of Trade survey next year, and I have the pleasure to say that under the special circumstances the Committee have decided to allow the vessels' classes to remain undisturbed subject to this arrangement being carried out.

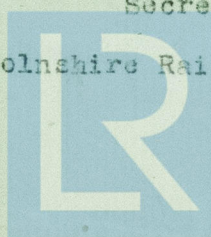
