With reference to your letter of the 26<sup>th</sup> inst, I have to say that it was in contemplation to withdraw our vessels from Lloyd's classification, and pending settlement of the question both the "Lutterworth" and the "Lincoln" passed the Board of Trade Survey, without your Surveyors being called in, consequently these two vessels will have to stand undasses.

I believe, however, it will ultimately be the Company's decision to continue their fleet in your Society's Register Book.
