Nature of Survey

S.S. No 1

The S.S. No 1 became due in June last.

The Hull Surveyors now state that, as this vessel has just passed her Annual Board of Trade Survey, the Superintendent wishes to defer holding the S.S. No 1, until the vessel is submitted to the Board of Trade Survey next year.

This proposal is, in the Hull Surveyors' opinion, worthy of the favourable consideration of the Committee, in view of the condition of the vessel with which they are well acquainted.

It is submitted that:— The Owners proposal to defer the S.S. No 1 until the next annual survey for the Board of Trade, which, merits the favourable consideration of the Committee as the year of grace will not expire until the end of June next year.
