I regret to have to inform you that I omitted to acquaint your Surveyors of the District, of this vessel being in the dry dock for her annual B. I. survey, and for them to inspect the vessel.

I might mention that your Mr. Williamson of Hull did see her last year when in the dry dock but as the class was with drawn at the time and for a short period I understand he did not report the sighting of bottom.

As we do not wish to dry

dock the vessel again, I shall be obliged if you will kindly accept this, and I shall be pleased to open the boilers for your Surveyors' inspection at any time suitable to himself.

The omission occurred through being under the impression at the time that your Surveyors had inspected her last year.
