It will be observed that the weight of the chain is $1\frac{21}{2}$ lbs. less than prescribed by Table 22. The makers have desired the Builders to request me to submit the case, and, owing to the slight deficiency in the weight, I would respectfully submit that it might be favourably considered by the Committee.
