I am directed to call your attention to the fact that in the case of the steamer "POINTZ CASTLE", your yard No.208, which has been before the Committee at their meeting this day, the chain cables are less in weight than required by Table 22 of the Society's Rules, being 22lb. light on the length of 75 fathoms, and I have to remind you that the weights of cables prescribed in Table 22 are minimum weights and must be strictly complied with and the Committee must ask you to kindly see that this requirement is adhered to in all future cases.
