M With reference to my letter of yesterday, respecting the steel screw tug "NEWARK", built by Mr. J. S. Watson, of Gainsborough, I now return herewith as promised the plan of this vessel forwarded with Mr. Wilson's letter of the 1st instant, and with regard thereto I am directed to inform you that provided the steel used in the construction of the vessel has been made by the open hearth process and satisfactorily tested, particulars of which should be supplied for the information of the Committee; the scantlings shown on the plans be verified; the vessel be surveyed and favourably reported upon by you, and be found or placed in good condition, she will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the Class A-, "For towing purposes".

If the figure 1 is desired, the equipment should be supplied in accordance with Table 22 of the Rules.
