Equipment.

This vessel was classed on the 1st March 190A
Aroning Deck with freeboard as certificates were not
produced for the 2nd Bower Anchor or the
Chain cables & stream chain.

The Hull Surveyors now report that
the Equipment has been again examined
& that certificates for the anchor in question
& the Chain cables have been produced &
the marks thereon found to correspond with
those on the anchor & chain cables.

90 fathoms of steel wire of proper size &
test have also been supplied in lieu of the
stream chain.

It is submitted this vessel
appears worthy now to be classed
