Gentlemen,

I am in receipt of Mr. Wilson's letter of the 28th instant, enclosing an application for survey with a view to classification of the Steamer "HERKULES", No. 585 in R.B., which vessel is now posted "Dismantled", and in reply thereto I am directed to inform you that if it is desired to class the vessel with this Society all the requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No. 3 must be complied with.

I have further to state that it is desirable you should in the first instance obtain from the Owners plans showing the scantlings and arrangements of the hull of the vessel and forward the same to this Office for consideration, in order that it may be determined whether the vessel will be eligible for a class in the Society's Register Book. At the same time a plan of the boilers and particulars of the engines and shafting should be forwarded for consideration.
