Dear Sir As requested by your of the 8 ins marked  
as above. I inspected the wood barge "Maorie"

It beg to enclose report of same. also a rough  
Sketch showing the defect in forman head. No 1 show  
where pieces have been cut out on the port side and  
the extent they are in before coming to good wood. the place  
marked Harbours shows the position of the damage on that side  
you will also see that this mast have a piece 6" thick  
& 7 feet long already fitted to fore side of mast. secured  
by four screw hoops. thus only leaving 9" of wood if the  
same was good. No 2 shows the mast as fished by round  
spar about 9" by the request of the Bo of I survey before  
allowing her to proceed from Londonderry to Wexford. the owners  
now propose to introduce three hoop on same as shown in  
red. In my opinion this is not safe for the contemplated  
voyage
