Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your Bk. "MAORI", and the correspondence which I had with you in April last, I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel again under consideration at their meeting this day, when they had before them a report from the Society's Surveyor at Ipswich, and as it appears that defects were found to exist in the hull of the vessel and you declined the further services of the Society's Surveyor, the Committee regret they have no other alternative than to expunge the vessel's class with a black line thus 6.92 indicating that the vessel, from reported defects, is not entitled to a character in the Register Book.
