We hereby engage to pay the established ~~Special~~ Survey Fees as per ~~Sec. 18 of the Yacht Rules~~, as follows, viz.

Section 18. The following Fees to be charged to Owners for surveying yachts during their construction, and for their Classification in the "Yacht Register" :—

For each Yacht under 5 tons, £3 ; of 5 tons and under 10 tons, £5 ; of 10 tons and under 20 tons, £7 ; of 20 tons and under 40 tons, £10 ; of 40 tons and under 70 tons, £13 ; of 70 tons and under 100 tons, £15 ; of 100 tons and under 150 tons, £17 ; of 150 tons and under 225 tons, £19 ; 225 tons and under 300 tons, £21.

For Yachts of greater size, One Shilling per ton additional beyond 300 tons.

For Special Survey of Machinery or New Boilers, to entitle them to the distinctive mark \boxplus in red, Three Shillings per Horse-power. No Fee to be less than £6 6s.

For the survey and testing of Donkey Boilers, Two Guineas.

MEM.—It is to be understood that in exceptional cases an additional charge will be made according to the service performed, and that in all cases where travelling expenses are incurred by the Surveyors in connection with the above services, they are to be defrayed by the parties interested in the same.

X.B.—If the requirements of the Surveyors be not complied with, the distinctive mark \boxplus showing that the Yacht has been built under Special Survey, will not be prefixed to the Class in the Yacht Register Book.

In no case can the Yacht be classed until all fees, travelling expenses, &c., due thereon are paid.
