REPAIRS

This Vessel has made a Voyage to China since last surveyed She was now docked to inspect the state of the plates of the bottom which were found remarkably clear of shells and grass &c. having been taken to keep her clean during the voyage & very little more corrosion was observable on the plates since last seen and as formerly was greatest from the light water mark downwards and more in various parts of some particular plates than others. The outer ends of a few of the ribs were slightly corroded which might be caused by their being injured in Chenchung - Not the slightest movement was observable in any part of the Vessel
