REPAIRS Now done, - The outside surface of Bottom plating scraped and payed with two coats of composition paint.

Remarks, - This Vessel is similar to the Iron Screw Collier "Manley Hill" classed 6A1, except in the following respects, viz, inferior in having the majority of the Deck, and the whole of the Hold Beams of single angle iron, - and superior in having Reverse angle iron on the Ribs, to above turn of Bilge, and the Hold Beams forward and aft fastened to every alternate frame.

She has three Iron Bulkheads up to the main Deck.
