Last Survey, No. 812 Port Iron Classed A

REPAIRS *now done viz:-* The inside surface of plating its corrosion beaten and scraped off above the bilges, payed with one coat of red lead. The outside surface of bottom and topsides scraped and payed with two coats of black varnish.

Remarks:- This vessel was built under Special Survey prior to the promulgation of the Iron Rules. (See Special Report No. 13239) and is similar in construction to the Iron Screw Ship "Chester" Classed CA1. (built the same time and place)
