## REPAIRS

At present Afloat. having been in dry dock. All the Engines and Boilers are entirely new. The Ceiling in Hold in way of Engines and Boilers lifted, and inside surface of plating there, coated with Asphalte from Keelson to Bilges, and at ends with Red Lead. Bottom Coated with three coats of Red Lead and one of Composition. Part of Upper Deck between Hatchways over Engine Room, new. She is now in good Condition.
