REPAIRS

Starboard side, In consequence of damage thro. striking the Pier at the entrance of this harbour, Bottom plating deranged clean to the load line, ceiling inside lifted as low as bilge keelsons. Fourteen bent & broken outside plates renewed, Five bent do. taken off rolled & replaced, Fourteen feet of hold beam stringer, & six ft of Deck beam do. renewed, Twelve broken frames cut above bilge stringer & new do fitted including reverse bars, with 4 ft corresponding angle iron fitted over butts. Several bent frames heated & set fair. Three frames new at the heads in engine room. 40 ft of waterway renewed in way of after hatch & 14 ft of do. forward with Red Pine. On both sides 70 ft of Roughtree rail & 9 do. stanchions renewed with E.C. Bulwarks, Top gallant rails, stanchions, bulwarks & look out bridge partly renewed & repaired. Cat heads new. Decks caulked. Bottom coated with three coats of paint, Ceiling relaid, Mizzen Topmast, Gaff, boom, & jib boom with mizen rigging new.
