Now Done

All Oxidation removed by scraping and Hammering inside and out, coated inside from Belves to Keelson with Portland Cement, and inside & out with Red Lead and from Keel to Wales with one coat of Composition over two coats of Red Lead, Channels removed chain plates refitted, Strake of Deck next Waterway on Upper Deck from Poop forward renewed, Mizzen Mast & Windlapp renewed, Upper Deck recoated. The outside plating as far as could be seen is in good condition and not materially affected by oxidation
