REPAIRS & Alterations

Boilers taken out, both surfaces of outside plating cleaned and painted, 200 rivets renewed in hull and garboard strakes, Removed Ten hold beams & three half beams, and refitted in lieu Seven hold beams of double built iron $7\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{4}$ with double angle iron $2\frac{1}{2} \times 3 \times \frac{1}{4}$ and plate iron on top $11 \times \frac{3}{4}$, Pillars fitted to hold beams 4" diam, and vertical knee plates fitted to the alternate frames in wide spaces, rivetted to the frames & stringer in the beam ends, The Sheer strakes doubled outside with plate iron $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ wide extending from the bluff of the bows to aft part of main mast in length 170 feet single rivetted at edges & butts with $\frac{1}{2}$ rivets, and renewed the rivets through the frames, and double rivets at the butts of the sheer strakes through the outside doubling with $\frac{1}{2}$ rivets. New Boilers fitted.
