## REPAIRS

At present cleaned and coated outside with Red lead and Peacock's composition. new Main Topmast. a stream Anchor and 45 fathoms of stream chain now supplied to make good deficiencies — Referring to my notes I find

In March 1860. This vessel was surveyed by Mr Martin & myself when the ceiling of main hold was lifted from main to bilge keelsons the plating and rivets were in very good condition, and then riveted a length of ceiling was also taken off tween deck on each side & the parts thus exposed were in good condition. — The owners have informed me of their intention (agreeably with the Rules) to submit the vessel to special survey on the return from her present intended voyage
