REPAIRS In consequence of having been in collision on her late voyage has now had 12 Iron plates taken out on the Starboard side and 4 do on the port side forward has also had 6 angle iron frames and four piece of stringer plate and all the loose and strained rivets taken out all replaced with new, fore-castle deck caulked as also the plating where required,
