The three after plates of Garboard removed on each side, the keel straightened and the plates refitted, the ceiling removed and the bottoms cemented with Portland Cement, the inside scraped and painted and the outside scraped and painted with three coats of patent paint, washcocks fitted on each side, Bulkhead valves refitted, Windlows stripped examined and found good, Whelps and linings new, Cables tested.
