## REPAIRS

Though damage sustained by collision  
 stem scarped at head 7 1/2 feet in length including scarp  
 one new plate to Newcastle on each side - one plate of the strake  
 on the Starboard bow removed to cut stem scarp. & refitted & re-  
 riveted - One length of plank to Newcastle on each side  
 of Baltic oak - Hawse chocks & pipes taken out refitted &  
 fastened. one new anchor davit -

Not of damage - The midship bulkhead of this vessel has at  
 present been cut at the lower part 12 feet wide by 7 1/2 feet high  
 by request of the owner, who has been written to & similar sub-  
 ject in connection with "John McIntyre" see Report by Mr Luke  
 and sketch accompanying it. -
