How Done

The Hold cleared, the ceiling partially ^{lifted} in each of the Holds, the ends of the ship cleared, two Boys of the Cement removed, and the several parts where exposed carefully examined, the Plating inside and outside, the rivets, frames, stelsons, stringers, Deck Comings and all other parts where seen found to be in good condition.

The Outside scraped and painted with three coats of patent paint. Windlows stripped examined and found good. Cables ranged and found sufficient.
